Registration

Foreign clubs have to fill up the competition's registration form at http://bit.ly/Olimpici2017 GP4 until midnight of 8th of March. One form per competitor.

Entry registrations start an hour before the actual event at a dedicated desk in the Sport Hall.

Final deadline of registration is strictly 30 minutes before the indicated start time of actual event.

Please be in time, this is a competition which involves many people!

Please be sure that the ID of competitors are not taken from the registration desk after turning up, or paying the fee off, otherwise it is impossible for the DT to set the ID's owner into competion!

Fencers are expected to hold a valid licence or competitor ID with a valid medical approbation, or photo ID which proofs date of birth. It can be passport, national ID or student card. If parents, coaches are worried of the risk loosing their passports, please bring other photo ID which also proofs date of birth.

Formula

According of the general rules of Hungarian Fencing Federarion, in the own competition formula of Olimpici GP. Moreover – the DT is assign to change the formula just before the start of any event!

Mini competitions.

2 rounds, no elimination (4 hits, 1×3 mins, 6–7 fencers). From the cumulative ranking list the first 16 fencers go onto tableau 16 (10 hits, 2×3 mins). **There is consolation** (repechage) on tableau 16. From place 17 competitors fence for placements in poules again (4 hits, 1×3 mins, 4–5 fencers) in the third round.

Novice competitions

1 round, no elimination! There is consolation (repechage) on tableau 16. Bouts for 15 hits, 3×3 mins.

Kid competitions

2 rounds, no elimination. From the cumulative ranking list the first 32 fencers go onto tableau 32 (10 hits, 2×3 mins). From place 33 competitors fence for placements in poules again (5 hits, 1×3 mins) in the third round.

Adolescent competitions

1 round, no elimination! Everyone goes onto direct tableau. Bouts for 15 hits, 3×3 mins.

Equipment and safety rules

- According to the rules of the FIE and the Hungarian Fencing Federation fencers in all age groups have to armed with equipments match the general safety regulations: compulsory to wear underplastron with FIE label of 800 NW sign; mask, jacket and breeches with FIE label of 350 NW sign.
- All helmets must be pass our mask controll before the events! Please make a strict care of helmets! Double check them before travelling! We take stricktly the FIE-rule as following: "If a helmet can not pass the control, the controller person is going to make that helmet visibly unusable in the presence of the involved fencer or their captain."
- In Mini age group weapons must be fitted with blade size ZERO, and small bell guard. This is compulsory!
- Staying in the piste area is allowed only to competitors, their coaches, and referees! We kindly ask parents and other companies to take a seat in the grandstand.
- Medical presence is ensured by the organisers.
- Organisers have no responsibility for lost or stolen properties!

Renumerates

Medals will be awarded to the first eight fencers per event.

In kid, novice and adolescent events 1st and 2nd receive a valued PBT-voucher. But there is a chance for each competitor to win the same voucher just like the 1st — with the "Lucky Pi System" operated by a random-selector software.

Referees

- The fencing clubs which are organising a tournament in the actual season provides one, or if it's possible two referees free of charge for the other clubs organising competitions in the same season.
- The bouts from tableau 16 are refereeing by the four main referee sent officially by the Hungarian Fencing Federation.
- Henceforth the foreign nations of entrants must provide referees as following:

One referee: if a nation registered 4–8 entrants for an event (for example kid boys).

Two referees: if a nation registered 9, or more entrants for an event.

This is not calculated along by clubs, but along by nations, all together. So please, make an egreement with fellow clubs. If a nation is unable or won't ensure referees, they must to pay 50 EUR penalty to the host club of the competition. If the foreign nations deny paying the penalty, it will result in exclusion of all entrants from that nation.

Olimpici GP competition is not dealing with names of foreign clubs anymore, all the foreign fencers will be signed by the name of their nations.
